Our Programs

AppleBerries Early Education Service Kallangur offers a renewed approach to education that works at catering for the emotional, physical, cognitive and spiritual needs of each child in their care.

Through our programs we prepare children for life and nurture the children at all ages to live happily together as members of a diverse community. They learn acceptance and understanding of all people and beliefs.

We encourage positive friendships with one another through tolerance and understanding.

The program at AppleBerries Early Education Service Kallangur is guided by the Early Years Learning Framework and the Queensland Kindergarten guidelines. It identifies five Early Years Learning and Development Outcomes for all children:

- Children have a strong sense of identity
- Children are connected with and contribute to their world
- Children have a strong sense of wellbeing
- Children are confident and involved learners
- Children are effective communicators



Room Structure

Our Centre is approved as a Long Day Care Centre for a maximum number of 65 children per day aged between 6wks to children turning 6yrs (school age).

Nursery: 6wks - 12 months

caters for up to 8 babies at a ratio of 1 educator per 4 babies

Toddlers: 12 months - 2 years

caters for up to 15 toddlers at a ratio of 1 educator per 5 children

Senior Toddlers: 2-3 years

caters for up to 20 children at a ratio of 1 educator per 5 children

Junior Kindy: 3-4 years

Caters for up to 28 children at a ratio of 1 educator per 11 children


Kindergarten: 4-5 year

Caters for up to 30 children at a ratio of 1 educator per 11 children

Each child is assessed through our Educational curriculum and that assessment is shared with families. Collaboratively we make an informed decision together which anticipates each child's movements/placement within the service. We foster our decisions based on several factors that put the child's development and wellbeing as the first priority.

Noosaville is open Monday to Friday
between the hours of **6.30am**
and 6.30pm up to 52 weeks per
year.

We are closed on all public holidays.



Fee Structure

Normal **fees are payable** by the last day of each week that your child attends, for the following two weeks. This ensures that you are always paid for the current week plus two weeks; being in advance at all times. Our preferred payment method is direct debit, a no cash policy applies.

We offer a holiday discount of 25% off your fees. Please give **two weeks notice** in writing and your account must be in advance to receive the discount. This will ensure that you retain your booking. This is available for up to four weeks in every calendar year. All fees need to be up to date to receive your reduction.

Because your child occupies a Permanent booking at the Centre, fees are payable for all booked days including absences, whatever the reason.

Daily Fee

Our fee schedule at AppleBerries Kallangur is as follows:

Nursery - Babies aged 6 weeks to 1 year
\$115 per day

Jnr Toddlers - Children aged 1-2 years
\$115 per day

Snr Toddlers: Children aged 2-3 years
\$115 per day

Jnr Kindy: Children aged 3-4 years
\$112 per day


Snr Kindy: Children aged 4-5 years
\$112 per day

Before School Care: Children 5-12 years
\$22 per day

After School Care: Children 5-12 years
\$29 per day

Vacation Care: Children 5-12 years
\$77 per day

We also have a bus service that drop children off from our centre to the school.



Childcare Subsidy

To make Child Care Subsidy (CCS) claims and view the status of your claims, families can go to my.gov.au and sign in to access their Centrelink online account. If you do not have a myGov account, you can create one and link it to your Centrelink online account.

Your CCS will be paid from the date of **approval** with Centrelink. If your child attends before your CCS is approved you may be required to pay full fees as CCS will not be backdated by Centrelink. If for any reason you are not eligible for CCS payments, you will be charged full fees for days that your child attends.

In order to receive CCS, **parents must sign every child in and out EVERYDAY** they attend the Centre.

To receive CCS for a child's absence, a record must be made of the reason for the absence. Upon your child's return to the centre please confirm and accept the electronic absence on the Kiosk and provide your medical certificate to the Service Manager if applicable.


Our learning programs aim to empower your child to express ideas and make choices about their learning. Your child's learning journey is recorded and shared, with you, via storypark.
